An **Introduction** (pp. 6-7) presents the theme, followed by a description of **Genes** (pp. 8-26). **Ways of Inheritance** (pp. 27-35) explains the physical events which take place in the transference of characteristics. These are then exemplified in a discussion of **Blood Groups** (pp. 36-43), which leads into an explanation of **Races** (pp. 44-51).

The text then returns to **Chromosome Dynamics** (pp. 52-59) and gives attention to **How Sex is Determined** (pp. 60-75). **Damage to Genes and Chromosomes** (pp. 76-97) is explained as a basis for an understanding of mutations, and we conclude with consideration of inheritance and environment or **Nature and Nurture** (pp. 98-117).

A **Glossary** (pp. 118-119) defines some essential terms used in the text and is followed by a brief **Bibliography** (p. 120) designed for further reading in **Genetics**.
