The author of this challenging book is **ROBERT A. MUNDALL**, Professor of Economics at the University of Chicago and Editor of the *Journal of Political Economy*.

Robert Mundell was born in Ontario, Canada, in 1932, and he received his B.A. from the University of British Columbia in 1953. He pursued his graduate and post-doctoral studies at the University of Washington, MIT, The London School of Economics, and the University of Chicago, receiving his Ph.D. from MIT in 1956.

Before joining the staff of the International Monetary Fund in 1961, Professor Mundell taught at the University of British Columbia, Stanford University, and the Johns Hopkins Bologna Center for the School of Advanced International Studies. He served as Visiting Professor at McGill University in 1963 and was a member of the OAS/IBD mission to Peru in 1964. Professor Mundell was the first Rockefeller Foundation Visiting Research Professor of International Economics at Brookings Institution (1964-1965) and was Ford Foundation Visiting Research Professor of Economics at the University of Chicago in 1965-1966. He is also associated with the Graduate Institute of International Studies in Geneva.

Professor Mundell has been a consultant to the Federal Reserve Board and the World Bank and has been a member of the Ballogio Study Group on International Monetary Reform. He has lectured widely throughout Germany, Italy, and England.
