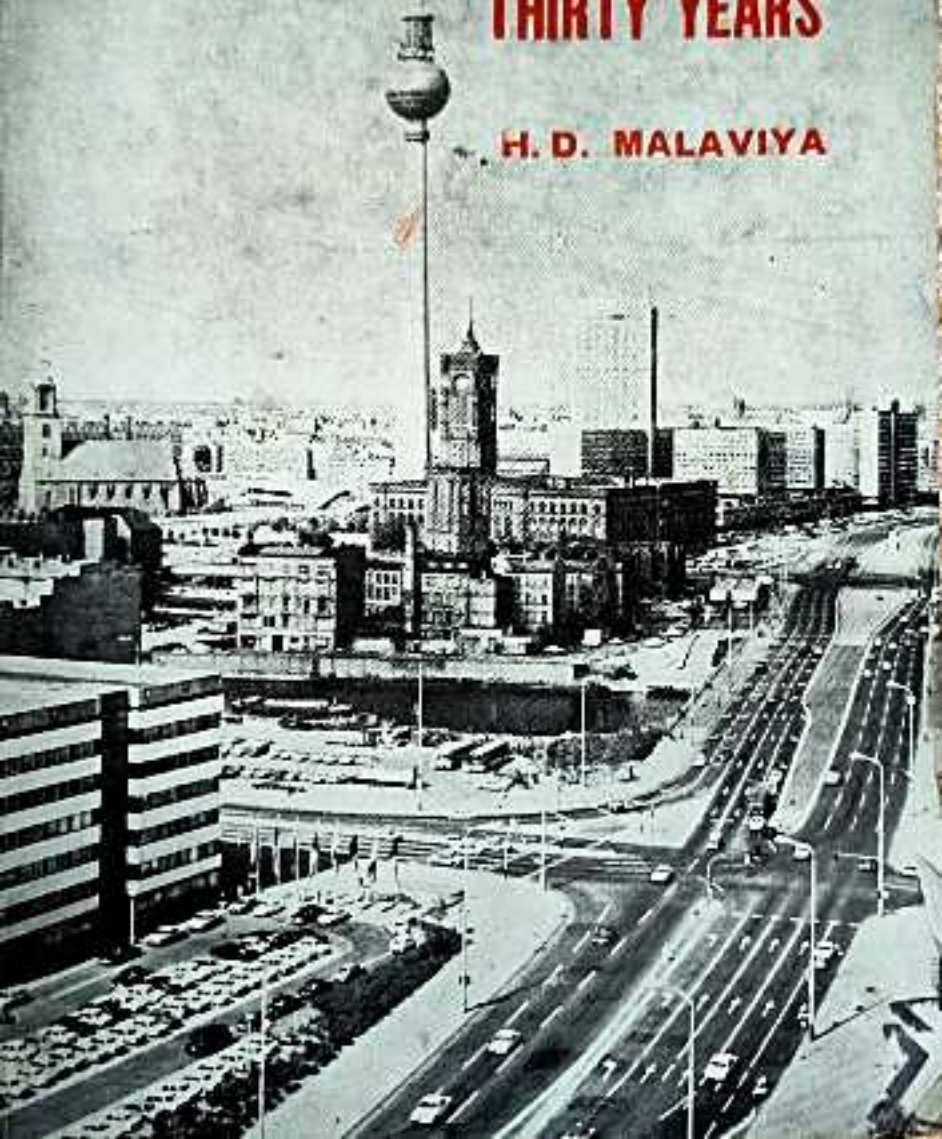

MALAVIYA, : born 1917; graduation Allahabad University; active in civil Disobedience Movement in 1930 at the age of 13; organiser of Kisan movement with late Swami Sahajanand; detained by British rulers during World War II; held important positions in Indian National Congress; Secretary, U.P. Zamindari Abolition Committee (1947-48); Secretary, Economic & Political Research Deptt., A.I.C.C. & editor of A.I.C.C. Journals (1948-1957); Member Administrative Reforms Committee, Kerala Government (1957-58); Indian Representative on Afro-Asian Solidarity Organisation at Cairo (1958-1960); Among founders and Convenor of Congress Socialist Forum, editor 'Socialist Congressman' (1961-1970); Indian Secretary in World Peace Council, Helsinki, Finland (1970-1972); Member, Indian Parliament (1972-1978); author of 45 books; books on Indian land problem recognised classics; works translated in German, Polish, Turkish Finnish; Korean and many Indian languages; travelled 60 countries; Nehru said "One of my ablest Colleagues".
